Dear Parents and Carers,

We feel lucky to offer 'Forest Schools' to Year 5 pupils (5SW, 5E and 5JT) as part of their wider school curriculum. This will take place on Wednesday morning, afternoon or Thursday afternoon depending on the class. We will be alternating the classes to ensure everyone is given the same amount of time, as swimming is also taking place on a Wednesday afternoon.

These sessions will be closely related to our Rainforest topic in Year 5 and our big question 'Is everyone born a survivor?' The lessons will include outdoor activities, such as: den building, making fires, cooking outside, gardening and habitat building.
