Numeracy 1-to-1 Tuition	A maths learning mentor employed to carry out 1-to1 tuition on all pupils who came in to the Academy achieving below a Level 4 in Maths in the KS2 SATS.		
English Small Group Tuition	An English teacher employed to carry out small group intervention with pupils in Y7 who arrived at the Academy achieving below a Level 4 in Reading in the KS2 SATS.		
Reading Recovery	Pupils receive 1-to-1 reading intervention if they arrive at the Academy with a Reading Age of below 9 years old.		
Lexia	A computer package purchased for the Academy that ALL pupils in Y7 complete an ability appropriate course to improve their Literacy.
