Reading Books and Accelerated Reading Quizzes

Reading books will be sent home with children each night and should be returned to school daily. We ask that adults listen to children read at least 3 times a week and record this in their planners on the weekly page on the right-hand side. In school, children will then have the opportunity to take their Accelerated Reader test once they have read the book and have shown they understand the contents. Here are some strategies to support your child with reading at home:
